Due to this the company got the possibility to develop further and within the following years NEFF changed from a handicraft enterprise to a worldwide operating middle sized company.

Today the company is a leading manufacturer of hydraulic presses and manufacturing lines for the complete forming industry. The origin of the continuous success is founded in our company philosophy and our know-how of the branch. In spite of our continuous success we were able to remain a mid-sized company and due to this being able to react fast and spontaneous to customer requirements.
